Message from Pastor Jeff

At our April quarterly congregational business meeting our church is going to make a decision about whether to change our current Sunday morning worship schedule. This decision affects everyone. This decision can seem scary. What if we change? Will my family and I be able to adjust to a new routine? What if our church gets into a big fight? What if people leave the church?

To anyone who may be experiencing a little anxiety over this upcoming process, I have one word for you - TRUST. Trust the Holy Spirit. Trust each other. Trust the process.

As a church family, we have faced many major decisions in the past and we have been fine. In the last 25 or so years you have worked through the difficult decisions about whether to add additions to the building, where to put those additions and how big to make those additions (you have built twice). And in that same time period you have also twice worked through the process of deciding to hire additional pastoral staff.

So we have faced hard decisions in the past and worked through them and been fine. And we will do the same thing here. And the reason we were fine in the past and we will be fine in the present is that we have put our trust in the right places: the Holy Spirit, each other and the process.

Trust the Holy Spirit. As Christians, we have the Holy Spirit living in us. And Jesus tells us in John chapters 14 and 16 of all of the wonderful things the Holy Spirit will do for us and through us. And one of those things is that through the Holy Spirit we can have wisdom (John 16:12-15).

We have trusted God in the past, and He has led us. God is using us now. Our ministry is significant. God isn't going to leave us on our own. If we seek Him, we will find Him. We just need to listen and trust. Proverbs 3:5-6 says, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and He will make your paths straight."

Trust Each Other. I have lived and worked with you for over 25 years. I know you love the Lord. I know that you are committed to the mission of the Evangelical Covenant Church in Lindsborg: worship, witness, teach and serve. I have seen you seek God's counsel on other difficult decisions, I know you will do it again on this decision too. I trust you to seek God's guidance on this matter.

Trust the Process. As a church we adopted a set of rules to live by almost 50 years ago called the constitution. In this constitution we are told that the important decisions our church family makes are done by the group as a whole, relying on our equal access to the guidance of the Holy Spirit, trusting that each one of us is seeking God's will for our church. This process has worked so well for us in the past. I know it will work for us now.

So, as we go through this process, let's not be afraid, but trust in the Lord with all our heart because we know that He will make our paths straight.






Women's Fellowship Night Friday, February 24, 6:30 p.m.



This has been a remarkable year. Our leadership in the International School project (ISP) (Roy as the Executive Director and Joi as the Director of Movement Building and Discipleship) has literally taken us around the world again and again. Our

meetings with Ministers of Education, regional education officials, ministry leaders, and many, many teachers have been the highlight of our year. We rejoice with each changed life' and there have been many! We rejoice that the Lord is using ISP to start spiritual movements of educators around the world. As we come alongside teach-

ers and help plant movements that begin to grow and become self-sustaining and self-propagating, it is very clear that ISP is a work of God, not of men. It is an honor to be used by Him and to be a part of His work.

Please pray for us as we have a growing number of new countries and cities inviting us to begin work. We are going to be expanding to 4 or more new countries next year, but the difficult decision is deciding whom we have to ask to wait.

We continue to need and deeply value your prayers as a family. We are blessed that despite our heavy travel schedules, Joi and I often get to minister together.

I often say that in ISP our daily lives are characterized by the miraculous. It is hard to express the excitement of getting to watch the hand of the Lord at work. Once again, thank you for your partnership in our joint ministry.

From Julie McLaughlin

As we are wrapping up 2016, it's kind of a ridiculous one. We delivered 71,749 medical services, this our first official year of operating the Pacific Link. We visited 125 villages and served 40,229 people. With that, we presented the Gospel to

34,313 people and 3,153 of them made commitments to follow Jesus. We delivered 5,837 digital and paper Bibles.

As 2017 dawns, I'll make a quick Advance trip up to East New Britain squeezed in between the new year and our departure for the Sepik River. This will be our final two

Outreaches for the Province and also going into the most remote places so far.

We will sail from village to village doing eye surgeries on board and dentistry and other clinics on land. We'll have 7 land-based teams going into the inland villages. We are also partnering with Samaritan Aviation who has two float planes who will take some of our medical teams to even more remote parts of the river.

It's sure to be a glorious chaos. Thanks for your prayer and support!
