

March 2017 Life Together Lindsborg Covenant Church

Message from Pastor Darrell

It is always risky to assess the historical significance of any event as it is happening. Things that seem monumental as they occur may fade from our collective consciousness fairly quickly. And things that seem rather inconsequential may, in time, prove to be watershed events.

That said, I will go out on a limb and say that I feel like our church may be wading through water of the "shed" variety. I am referring to the two proposals that the Diaconate has put before us regarding the Sunday morning worship schedule.

By way of review, approximately 95% of the congregation is content with the worship schedule the way it is. There is little or no motivation to change it for internal reasons. However, the pastors and the Diaconate have agreed that for outreach purposes it is much easier to reach unchurched people with contemporary music and a late-morning start time. So the Diaconate is bringing two proposals to the April 30th Congregational Meeting to address this potential shift.

Proposal #1 is to change the start time of the services. Specifically, first service would be from 9:00-10:00 a.m., Sunday School from 10:15-11:15 a.m., and second service from 11:30 a.m. -12:30 p.m. We think this is a good move because 8:00

a.m. is a difficult start time for most people and an extra hour of sleep will be a gift to whichever service gets put in the earlier time slot. Service and transition times get shortened a bit, but Sunday School still gets a full hour.

Proposal #2 is to then swap the order of the services, putting the Traditional Service in the early slot and the Contemporary Service in the late slot. Our reasoning is that churched people are already committed to Jesus and church attendance and are more likely to be willing to make schedule compromises in order to participate in worship that is meaningful to them. Unchurched people, by definition, are not committed to any of that, so they are less likely to sacrifice either sleep or music preferences to come check us out.

February was all about information. We had a series of three informational meetings in which we explained the two proposals and gave opportunity for feedback and discussion. March and April are all about prayer. We are asking everyone to earnestly seek God's face and discern His will for our church on this matter. We will also have an all-church prayer meeting about this on March 26 at 6:30 p.m.

Then, on April 30th, during the quarterly congregational meeting, we will vote first on Proposal #1. We will count the ballots and report the results. A "Yes" vote is to change the start times. A "No" vote is to leave them the same. If the "Yes" votes win by a 2/3 majority we will change the service start times.

Then we will vote on Proposal #2. Again we will count the votes and report the results. A "Yes" vote is to swap the order of the services. A "No" vote is to leave them in the current order. If the "Yes" votes win by a 2/3 majority we will reverse the order of the services.

The vote results could be that we change nothing, in which case my "watershed" prediction becomes more of a "trickle-down-the-drain" moment, ;-) but I bring this up because this vote at least has the potential to make significant changes in the way we do worship on Sunday mornings.

As your pastors, we are asking you to please pray about this. We want everyone to ask God to reveal His will to us. And then we are asking everyone to vote, not necessarily according to your preferences, but according to your sense of God's will for us. And then we are asking everyone to accept the results of the vote as God's revealed will for us, to embrace it and help us make it fruitful for His Kingdom.

Will you please join us on our knees as we seek and serve our Savior together?



The risks taken by nurses who work at night have decreased significantly. 3. The high costs of kerosene for lamps and batteries for flashlights have been eliminated. 4. The risks and uncertainties that come from delivering babies at night have been eliminated. 5. Children that

have been hospitalized due to severe malaria now receive better care in well-lit facilities.

I hope you understand that your support has positively changed our work in these health centers, especially as it has decreased the risk of death for many of our people.

Our prayer every day is that God would bless you abundantly and return upon you a blessing one hundred times greater than what you have given for His work. May the love of our all powerful God, the grace of our Savior, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all!
