Message from Pastor Jeff

We live in a society that values many things money, fame and power - to name a few. But I am overjoyed to be associated with a group of people that value other things - relationships, souls, righteousness - to name a few. In fact, my feelings for this church are much like the Apostle Paul's feelings toward the Christians in Corinth when he wrote, "I have great confidence in you; I take great pride in you. I am greatly encouraged... my joy knows no bounds" (2 Corinthians 7:4).

There are so many reasons that I am encouraged by you: your faithfulness to teach and attend Sunday school classes, small group Bible studies and prayer meetings, your work with children and youth - to name just a few reasons. But most recently you have caused me to take great pride in you as you have the vision to reach out with the gospel through the Alpha Course.

The Alpha Course is an 11 week course that presents the basics of the Christian faith in a clear and winsome way. This course is primarily met as a tool for evangelism, but it has also proved to be an effective discipleship tool as we will cover basic topics like: Why did Jesus have to die? Why pray? Why read the Bible? Why go to church? Does Jesus still heal today?

There is a tremendous team of people who will be working in the kitchen to provide great meals for those who attend Alpha. There is another team that will set up the tables every week. And there is a team that will do the wonderful decorations for each Alpha night's special themes! There will be many small group leaders and helpers who are key to the ministry, as well as the people who will do the child care every week (unsung heroes).

If you are asked to help with the Alpha Course this fall, please prayerfully consider adding it to your already busy schedule. I know this is a big ask, but Alpha is worth it. Personally, the Alpha Course will add many hours to my week. And I know that it will add many, many hours to the weeks of all the people listed above. For this I am truly encouraged because I know that you are doing this so that others may be drawn closer to Jesus. Dietrich Bonhoeffer once said that, "The church is only the church when it lives for others." I take great pride in you because you are the church.




Palm Sunday, April 14, there will be regular worship services at 8:00 and 10:55, with Sunday school at 9:30.





It is our intention at Evangelical Covenant Church, Lindsborg that every child would have the opportunity to go to camp. We realize that not every family may be able to afford the full amount of the camp fee. Therefore, the following options are available:

- A) Pay the deposit (\$30 for Covenant Kids, \$75 for Jr./Sr. High) which will accompany the registration form, and then pay the balance when it is due.
- B) Pay the deposit (see above) which will accompany the registration form, and then the church will cover the balance. You can pay the church back on installments. (Please let the office staff know of your plans when you drop off your registration form and deposit.) Payments may be made to Covenant Church marked camp registration.
- C) Pay the deposit (see above) which will accompany the registration form, and request a camp scholarship for the balance due. Partial scholarships can be worked out if you can pay part of the balance due. Partial scholarships may be requested from the church office, for Covenant Kids camp, or for Jr./Sr. High - Jim Christopher, 668-2477.
- D) Full scholarships are available for those who are unable to pay the deposit and the balance due. Requests for full scholarships may be made by contacting the church office or Jim Christopher, see above contact information.

Missions Reports

From Sarah Shultz, Working with Medair, an Emergency Relief Organization

Hi from Beni (DR Congo)!

It's my first week at my base location! I flew here with a couple of other new colleagues from the capital city of the province, Goma, on Monday.

The team in Beni consists of 10 international staff, all living at a team base compound, and about 100 local Congolese staff. The town is relatively quiet, with 3 banks, a couple of grocery stores, a few hotels, and a small airport as well as smaller shops in the city center. The office is a 10 minute walk away from the house.

Most projects here are currently focused on Ebola response. In August 2018, the second-largest outbreak ever (after the 2014 outbreak in West Africa) began. WASH (water & sanitation) teams are setting up hand washing stations in villages to prevent the spread of the disease, local health centers are being educated on the warning signs of Ebola, communities are taught not to eat bushmeat and safe burial practices, and Medair has set up an Ebola transit center, where suspected cases can go to safely be tested.

I'm not doing any of that:) I'm here as support - helping run the programs. I'm helping look at budgets to see what we can buy, approving purchases, transferring money from local banks, making sure we have all of the correct paperwork to work in this region and that we're accountable to donors, and mainly for now, to work in HR to make sure we have qualified staff to carry out all of these functions.

My local counterpart is Leon, and he knows everything about Congolese labor law (it's COMPLICATED) and Medair's HR policies (also complicated).

My supervisor is Esther, from Germany, who has been in and out of Congo since 2010 so is also very knowledgeable, and is helping me learn all about finance, HR, and logistics.

Covenant Kids Congo is excited to announce a new project in Karawa, DR Congo. The Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) for Improved Health at Karawa Hospital Project is about to be launched, scheduled to begin right away and to be completed by the end of 2020.

Karawa, a remote city in northwest DR Congo, is located about a three-hour drive away from Gemena on bumpy roads. The CEUM's Karawa Hospital is a major referral hospital in this zone. It provides 24-hour services and treats major illnesses and injuries.

In Karawa, only 5% of the population has access to drinking water, compared to 12.1% in the Nord-Ubangi Province and about 26% nationally. Meanwhile, only 0.9% of the Nord-Ubangi population uses improved sanitation facilities. With a deteriorated water supply station, Karawa Hospital only has access to clean water three times a week (Monday, Wednesday, and Friday), for one hour at a time. Water is critical for safe care at the hospital, and yet an initial report indicated that only 7% of the needed water is available there.

Covenant Kids Congo powered by World Vision plans to rehabilitate the existing water supply systems to meet the World Health Organization standard of 40 liters of water per patient and 15 liters per caregiver, while also bringing sanitation and hygiene services up to standard.

As a result of increased CKC WASH fundraising, we celebrate that the total budget for this project has already been covered! More than \$1 million was raised for CKC WASH in 2018.
